Issues:

- › Critical - Word substitution: "Open Horizon" instead of "IBM Edge Computing"
- › Critical - Variable interpolation: `{{ site.data.keyword }}` not being replaced
- › Critical - perform all reviews before publishing
- › MVP - Directory indexing: should auto-generate index page of links to documents with title & description extracted from .md files in folder
- › Ongoing - maintain list of missing items to address at a later point, should open as GitHub issues
- › Not MVP - Plan for images (SVGs)
- › Not MVP - process to crawl files, seed list. Confirm no orphan pages, no bad links, valid markup
