
Issues:

- > Process to crawl files, seed list. Confirm no orphan pages, no bad links, valid markup




Original Chart







Mermaid Chart








Updated Chart

 - New example will be created

Issue 29

- > Repositories must move files to \docs folder
- > Then turn on github-pages for that repo as sub-folder of main doc site
- > Then find a way to "symlink" the _config.yml and _folders from main doc site Lines of investigation include:
 - Git Submodules
 - Git Subtrees
 - > ???
 - > Avoiding hard-coding separate copies in each repository
