## Integrate in-place repository .md files

- › [Issue 29](#)
  - › Repositories must move files to \docs folder
  - › Then turn on github-pages for that repo as sub-folder of main doc site
  - › Then find a way to “symlink” the \_config.yml and \_folders from main doc site  
Lines of investigation include:
    - › Git Submodules
    - › Git Subtrees
    - › ???
    - › Avoiding hard-coding separate copies in each repository
