Current issue status

Repo	open-horizon.github.io
New Issues	5 (-1)

Decision: Documentation from contributed code

- Assumptions ...
 - > code will live in a new repo
 - documentation does not match our implicit style guide
 - documentation does not match our implicit best practices
 - documentation may not be in vanilla markdown format
 - > therefore, it will require refactoring
- Options:
 - > Keep it as-is and just link to it
 - > Embed it, and refactor slowly
 - > Embed it and refactor immediately
 - > Or ???



What's New: <u>Issue 2853</u> – Exclude PRs from e2e testing IF files in /docs

- When we update documentation files in a repo (any repo) and the PR only contains those documentation updates, there's no reason to run the e2e regression test.
- Possible selection criteria:
 - If it only contains HTML, MD, CSS, JS, SVG, JPG, GIF, PNG, TXT files
 - > If it only contains files in /docs
 - Or some other criteria





Update: Copying anax/docs to open-horizon.gitub.io/anax

- > PR #104 was submitted, merged
- > Now we need to remove the GitHub Pages configuration from anax
- > Then confirm it is working as anticipated
