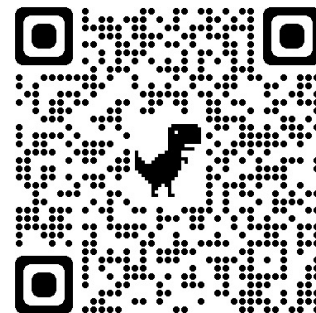

Decision: Documentation from contributed code

- › Assumptions ...
 - › code will live in a new repo
 - › documentation does not match our implicit style guide
 - › documentation does not match our implicit best practices
 - › documentation may not be in vanilla markdown format
 - › therefore, it will require refactoring
- › Options:
 - › Keep it as-is and just link to it
 - › Embed it, and refactor slowly
 - › Embed it and refactor immediately
 - › Or ???

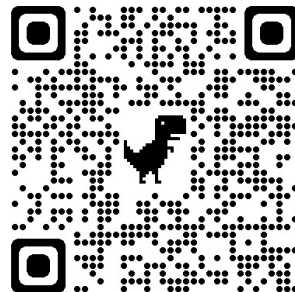
What's New: [Issue 2853](#) – Exclude PRs from e2e testing IF files in /docs

- › When we update documentation files in a repo (any repo) and the PR only contains those documentation updates, there's no reason to run the e2e regression test.
- › Possible selection criteria:
 - › If it only contains HTML, MD, CSS, JS, SVG, JPG, GIF, PNG, TXT files
 - › If it only contains files in /docs
 - › Or some other criteria

- › Now we need to remove the GitHub Pages configuration from anax
- › Then confirm it is working as anticipated
