



#### Creation of new repositories

- > Documentation configuration will require sub-modules to promote re-use
  - New documentation\_data repository mounted as \_data
  - New documentation\_includes repository mounted as \_includes
  - New documentation\_layouts repository mounted as \_layouts









#### Feature Request Lifecycle in late ideation phase

- > Present to the TSC for final feedback
- Goal is to define how
  - > Anyone in the community can request new functionality
  - > Chair(s) can determine which WGs will work on the new feature
  - > Assigned WG Chair can ensure resources are available to work on the feature
  - Units of functionality can be tested, merged, and used immediately independent of the whole feature
  - > The process can meld Design Thinking keys, Agile/KanBan development processes, and GitHub/ZenHub tooling
