







#### FYI: linuxfoundation added as GitHub owner

- Ben Courliss: "In general I don't think the DevOps WG should own all GitHub Actions. The DevOps WG can be a source of information and knowledge on how to create them, but I feel it should be up to each repo to own their own actions, especially when it comes to building their code." An exception to this would be Actions that apply to all repos.
