 - Explicitly define a project governance and committer process. This is preferably laid out in a GOVERNANCE.md file and references a CONTRIBUTING.md and OWNERS.md file showing the current and emeritus committers.
 - Have a public list of project adopters for at least the primary repo (e.g., ADOPTERS.md or logos on the project website).

 - Documentation repo?

FYI: Adopter IBM released version 4.3 of IEAM

- Open Horizon features and enhancements included in their release:
 - > Secrets Manager secure storage and deployment of sensitive information
 - > Internal TLS optionally enable TLS for internal Management Hub calls
 - > Agent on Power now supported on ppc64le single server
 - > Multi-tenant SDO SDO now supports all organizations in an instance
 - > Agent on Ubuntu now supports Ubuntu 20.04.2
 - Networking enhancements dependent services can now communicate with parent through network alias as defined in Service Definition file
