Decision on Maintainers

- Community Membership defines as: Contributors who have commit access to repositories, may fill leadership roles in Working Groups, and have demonstrated positive contributions over time to further the goals of the project.
- ➤ We would like to have a central MAINTAINERS.md file listing the Maintainers, if practical. Do we:
 - Have a single file (in .github repo) and call out Maintainers per repository?
 - Have a MAINTAINERS.md file per repository showing Maintainers there?
 - Or do Maintainers have commit privileges on all repos and we just have a single file?
 - Or something else?



Decision on Contributors expiration date, if any

- > Do we distinguish between Active and Emeritus (non-Active) Contributors?
 - LF Edge guidelines recommends that we do, but has no proposed metrics
 - If so, what is the demarcation? One year of no contributions?
- > This will affect how we list Contributors in our CONTRIBUTORS.md files
