# Decisions

## Report from Agent WG on mimik code contribution

- › Jeff Lu demo'd mimik's integration of Open Horizon with edgeEngine
  - › Allows deployment of services and models to edge nodes w/o Docker runtime
  - › Does not require modifications to Management Hub components
  - › Does not require modifications to Service Definitions or Deployment Policies
  - › Requires installation of integration code and edgeEngine components on both:
    - › Edge Node containing at least two containerized Agents: node and target device
    - › Target Device containing edgeEngine
  - › Integrated devices registered by, and deployable to, just like any edge node
- › Proposed contribution is one repo (oh-orchestrator) and ongoing upkeep
- › Does this contribution qualify mimik for project Partner status?

**Partners** – Non-maintainer persons or organizations that have materially contributed to the project and are thus stakeholders in the project deliverables.
