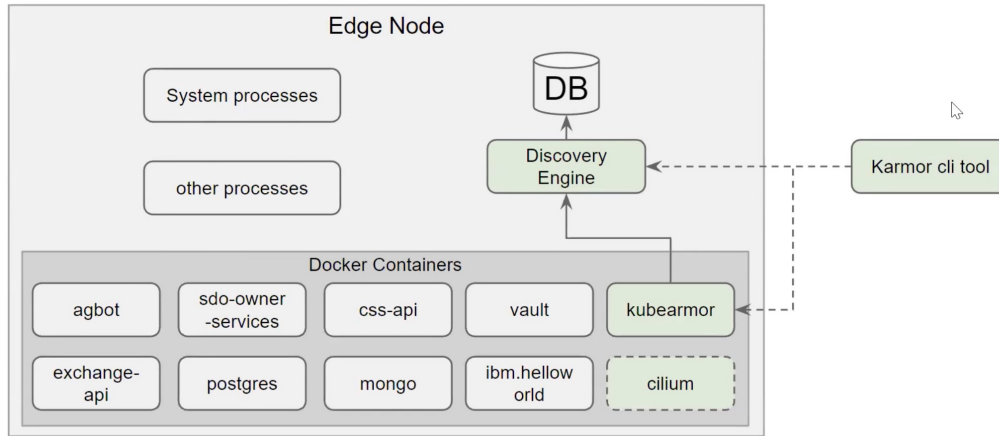

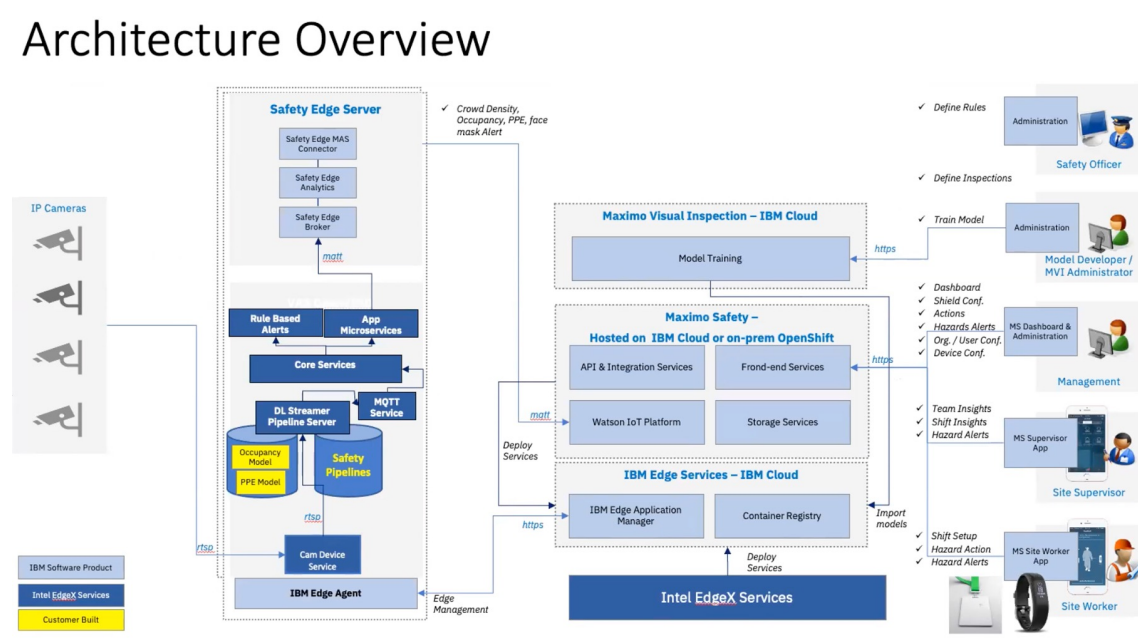
- Observe workloads
