### Previously ... Year in Review 2022

#### > Here's a blurb I sent:

Over 2022, the Open Horizon project has been improving community growth and engagement. Our <u>Mentorship program</u> has worked with IBM JumpStart, P-Tech, RCOS, and LFX to engage with at least 20 students and early career professionals. Two companies have joined our project as Partners and voting members of our Technical Steering Committee (TSC): mimik Technologies and AccuKnox. And we had a successful Hacktoberfest, engaging with 16 new Contributors, merging over 30 PRs from them.
